

Martin Luther and the Diet of Worms

This was <u>not</u> an unpleasant form of self-mortification undertaken by the great scholar who began the Reformation in 1517 in Germany.

Luther was a Catholic monk and professor of Biblical Interpretation at the University of Wittenburg, whose studies of the text of the Bible brought him to the conclusion that the Catholic Church had strayed from the teachings of our Lord. In 1517 he drew up his 95 theses elaborating exactly how the Church had become corrupt, eg by the sale of indulgences, and nailed (or possibly pasted) this list to the door of the Wittenburg church.



He then wrote some fiery theological treatises along the same lines, effectively condemning the Catholic Church. This caused Pope Leo X to excommunicate him in 1521, and Luther was summoned by the Holy Roman Emperor Charles V to the city of Worms to defend his heretical beliefs before the deliberative assembly or Diet. He was urged to withdraw his theses, but vowed he would only do so if he was proved to be in error by Scripture or by reason. He refused to recant and is reputed to have stated firmly "Here I stand. I can do no



other". Charles V promptly passed the Edict of Worms and declared Luther a heretic and an enemy of state. He spent a year in Wartburg Castle where he worked on translating the Bible from Latin into the German vernacular, thereby mak-

ing it accessible to other Christians. Martin Luther fought for the primacy of Scripture and effectively began the Reformation exactly 500 years ago this month (April).
