## Four Soils Parable

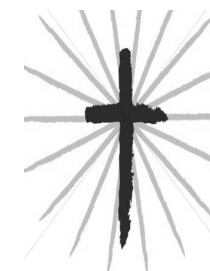

# Welcome to DBC

## *Martin Luther, Protestantism and the Clarity of Scripture*

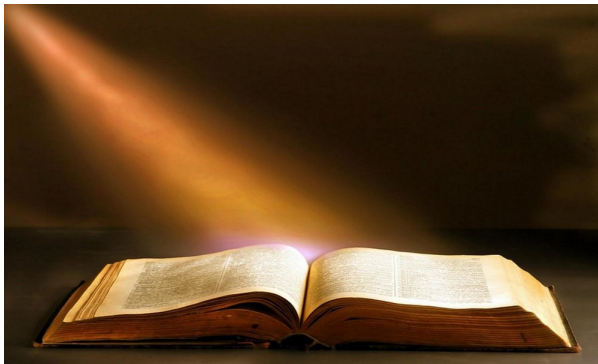
When Martin Luther nailed (or maybe glued) his 95 indictments to the Wittenburg church door, stating how the Catholic Church had lost its way, he gave great impetus to the Reformation and the division between Catholicism and Protestantism. Two of his most important contentions were that -

- Faith alone saves, not works, which are merely evidence of that saving faith.
- God speaks to all men through Scripture, and through Scripture alone - not through Papal pronouncements based on special knowledge gained by the position of the Pope as ruler of the church.

This being the case, Scripture must be clear to all men of goodwill who, with prayer, seek to understand and act on what they read in the Bible. Moreover the Bible must be available to humans in their native tongue, not just in Latin which was comprehensible only by the well-educated. On the flyleaf of the Bible that he first translated into German, Luther wrote -

*"God will not be seen, known, or comprehended except through his Word alone. Whatever therefore one undertakes for salvation apart from the Word is in vain. God will not respond to that. He will not have it. He will not tolerate any other way. Therefore, let his Book in which He speaks to you be commended to you. For he did not cause it to be written to no purpose. He did not want us to let it lie there in neglect, as if he were speaking with mice under the bench or with flies on the pulpit. We are to read it, to think and speak about it, and to study it, certain that He Himself, not an angel or a creature, is speaking with us in it."*

*The words of the Bible are food for the soul....*

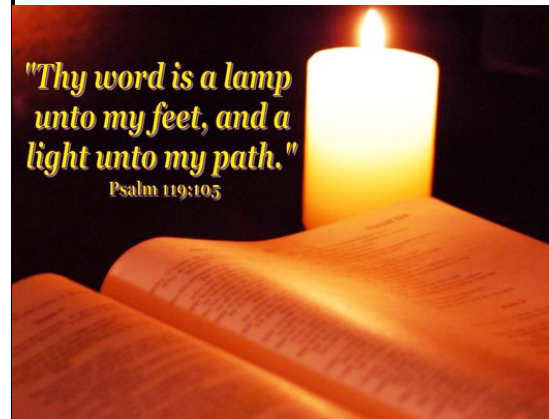


# Current Ministry News
